

Empty the JP Drain 2-3 times a day or as directed:

- 1. Wash hands.
- 2. Carefully remove plug from JP drain.
- 3. Turn upside down and empty into measuring cup.
- 4. Use one hand to squeeze all the air out, as pictured, use the other hand to replace the rubber stopper.
- 5. Record amount of drainage. Note the location (#).
- 6. Take this record of drainage with you when you return to your Dr's appointment.

It is important to keep your drain compressed at all times, to maintain suction and fluid collection. The drain promotes healing and reduces the chance of infection.

The first drain will be removed when output is < 25mls TOTAL for 24hrs for 2 CONSEQUETIVE DAYS. You must have an appointment for drain removal. Please call our office to schedule this when output meets criteria.
